### **Adel A. Malak Scholarship – USDA-FSIS-OFO**

Interested in becoming a Public Health Veterinarian? Consider applying for the Adel A. Malak scholarship. This prestigious award provides students with a \$15,000 scholarship, paid employment during summer and school breaks as a Veterinary Student Trainee, a permanent position with the FSIS Office of Field Operations (OFO) upon graduation, mentorship and professional development, and other employee benefits. The application process for the scholarship will be starting in January 2020; we are hoping to have the announcement open January 6<sup>th</sup> and be open for two weeks. After you apply on USAjobs.gov, our Human Resource (HR) department will evaluate your application to ensure you qualify for the program. HR will then refer a group of candidates to us for consideration. At that point, we will send out an email requesting additional documents, which include three letters of reference and an essay stating why you deserve to be the recipient of the scholarship. You will have two weeks to submit the additional information.
